History of the League

Founded in 1985 as an independent lay organization, the League received permission from the late Gerald Emmett Cardinal Carter to use the name Catholic. With a board of directors and membership that spans the country, the League is faithful to the teachings of the Magisterium and works in cooperation with local bishops across Canada.

League activities:

- Combat defamation and prejudice in the media.
- Defend those challenged in courts and human rights tribunals for upholding religious teachings in the public arena.
- Promote a culture of life through participation in abortion and euthanasia debates. Support freedom of religion and freedom of conscience for doctors and other professionals.
- Provide non-partisan voter information during election campaigns.
